2025 Attorney Training
Certification Requirements

To obtain eligibility credit for the 2025 Attorney Training in the Probate Court, attorneys are required to satisfy *all* the following requirements:

1. Attend the virtual October 9, 2025, **Afternoon** Attorney Training session offered by the Probate Court.
2. If you did not attend **any** of the Probate Court Attorney Training Sessions from 1996 - 2024, you must also attend the virtual October 9, 2025, **Morning** Attorney Training session.
3. Submit the “Attorney Profile Sheet” through the link provided on the Court’s website under Attorney Training.

Deadline for submission of Attorney Profile Sheet is ***November 26, 2025***.

4. Submit a copy of the “face sheet” (i.e., the declaration page showing a minimum aggregate level of liability coverage of \$250,000) from your malpractice insurance policy.*

Deadline for submission of malpractice insurance information is ***November 26, 2025***.

*Attorneys who otherwise meet the certification requirements but do not submit malpractice insurance information will be eligible for Guardian ad Litem or Guardianship Review assignments only.
